### Family Information

GENEVA is an early Titanic son from a cow that should cross very well on Titanic. Outside Gigi is the typical Outside daughter in many ways. She is a wide, powerhouse of a cow. She is always first at the feed bunk and is a trouble free cow. She walks on great feet and legs and has a perfect structure to the rump. All of these things add to her success in the milk pail as she produced over 60,000 pounds of milk and over 2500 pounds of fat as a 5-Year-Old. This family has produced top production cattle in the Brigeen herd for generations. GENEVA's Grandam, Gwen has 3 daughters all are Excellent. They include the Ex Outside dam of GENEVA, an Ex Allen and an Ex Storm. They all have huge records. Glory, the fourth dam of GENEVA has several great daughters including Mandel Golda who produced 51,000 pounds of milk and is the dam of the popular bull Givenchy. Her Rudolph sister, Ginger produced 53,000 pounds of milk and has 4 Ex daughters including Gillian who made 58,000 as a 3-year-old. Rarely will you find a family in the breed with scores and records like you do in this one. I would guess there are more 50,000 pound milk records in GENEVA's pedigree than any other bull in the business today.

### Daughter Information

GENEVA daughters will be milk cows. They will have great rear udders with deep udder cleft providing for the nice volume of milk on his daughters. They should be protected on fore udder attachments. GENEVA daughters will walk on very nice feet and legs with a great foot angle. While they are very good milk cows they have adequate strength and width and like the family will be aggressive cattle.

### Mating Information

GENEVA will cross well on BOLIVER, GARRISON, ROY, BRADLEY, Goldwyn, Toystory and Buckeye daughters.
