Alphonso's daughters combine Friesian type with milk high production. His pedigree includes three of the most popular bulls in the Friesian breed: Leighton Workboy x Bigforth Alphonso 2 x Wraxcourt Bounty.

### Family Information

Lakemead Emily 4 has given over 100 tonnes of milk at 3.5% protein and she looks very well, milking in her 10<sup>th</sup> lactation. She has calved regularly every 12 months and was classified BFE90 during her eighth lactation with an EX91 udder. Emily 4 is the dam of Lakemead Emily 22 BFV85, a very promising young cow. Emily 4 also has an impressive maternal half sister, Lakemead Emily 13 BFV85, that gave 9128kg in 305 days at 4.4%fat and 3.5% protein in her fourth lactation. Both are out of Lakemead Emily 3 that averaged over 9,000kg for nine lactations.

### Daughter Information

Lakemead Alphonso is outstanding for legs & feet, taking after his sire Leighton Workboy. Alphonso daughters are medium in stature, with shallow well attached udders. Many of his daughters are out of part Holstein cows and Alphonso has added strength and leaves steep foot angle. His daughters have excellent temperament and have performed very well on grassland farms in England and Wales – they have good locomotion and will last for many lactations.

### Mating Information

ALPHONSO provides an outcross on Gornal Pegasus bloodlines. He is also a good choice for using on daughters of Dovea Sem and for Holstein farmers looking to cross breed.
