Langley Brandysnap 3rd is an excellent choice for improving health traits - his daughters are easy calving and have low cell counts. Brandysnap is one of the top bulls for Fertility Index – his daughters are quick to get back in calf.

Brandysnap is bred from a cow family that combines high production with tremendous type. Langley Pegasus Ethel, his dam, is bred from an impressive line up of long lasting cows: CBS Ethel (100 tonnes in 9 lactations), Claybury Brandy Ethel (8 lactations), Claybury Bitter Ethel (12 lactations), Claybury Princess Ethel (10 lactations) and Claybury Lionel Ethel (15 lactations). Brandysnap is a full brother to Langley B Snap Ethel BFE91 and Langley B Snap Ethel 2 BFV85. Lovat Brandysnap, the sire of Langley Brandysnap 3rd, was a very popular bull with Friesian breeders and has excellent scores for lifespan, SCC and daughter fertility.

BRANDYSNAP 3rd is one of the best bulls available for improving milk production and his daughters combine many of the traits that Friesian breeders are looking for – they are developing into deep bodied Friesian type cows, with shallow udders.
