LIN will increase the fat content in the bulk tank with a lower SCS for several lactations. Also, LIN offers a little different sire stack which features the best daughters of their respective sires.

Family Information

LIN was bred by the Beiler Family of Ca-Lill Farms in Lancaster County, PA. Ca-Lill genetics have influenced herds world wide with the likes of Belltone and Cavalier. Both of these bulls appear in the pedigree of LIN. Outside was a logical sire to use on this very wet family to increase the fat percent. ABS had a VG full sister to LIN with a two year old record over 32,600 milk contracted. The family has developed the "old fashion" way by breeding back each year. The dam, Marble was the first animal in this family to be flushed and this did not happen until her second lactation.

Daughter Information

LIN daughters are built to survive in a variety of operations. They display more frame than normal with the ideal balance of strength and dairyness. They have great width thru the rump with some slope from hips to pins. The feet and legs are outstanding. They are track straight from the rear with a steep foot angle. The udders are carried well above the hock with a deep cleft and ideally placed teats.

LIN will work well on the BW Marshall bloodlines and daughters of BOLIVER, DIE-HARD, PROSPECT, TOUCHDOWN and TURNER.
