Customers looking for something “different” to use in their herd need not look any further than PATCH. A quick look below shows no O-Man, BMW, Manfred, Patron, Elton, Formation, Juror, Convincer, Rudolph, Outside, Mtoto, Duster, Melwood, Leadman or any Dellia descendant’s in his pedigree. Use this outcross bull to increase components, lower SCC and increase the important type traits.

Family Information

PATCH was bred by Bomaz Farms into a large 500 cows herd in Hammond, WI. He has a unique and outcross pedigree being a LOOKOUT x Finale x Highlight. This is the same family to produce HOMESTEAD and BOULDER. The dam of HOMESTEAD is also the dam of DISCOVER & PATCH and the Maternal Grand dam of BOULDER. 1551, a big massive all white cow with a youthful udder and ideal feet and legs, was always a visitor favorite. ABS has invested heavily into 1551 by sampling 14 sons. In the coming years we look forward to her DETROIT, DIE-HARD and Lynch sons getting proofs. The sire of 1551 is Peckenstein Prelude Finale. He was a Prelude son x Blackstar that died in waiting at Select Sires. The dam of 1551 is an awesome Highlight cow that made over 170 tonnes lifetime and is the only cow in the 5 generations behind PATCH that tested less than 4.3 for fat%. PATCH has 2 EX and 14 VG maternal sisters. He also has 3 VG full sisters that are heavily contracted to ABS. We have continued to invest heavily in this exciting outcross and successful AI family.

Daughter Information

PATCH daughters are built for profitability with their high components and longevity. They have outstanding rear udders that are high and wide and strong fore udder attachments. The PATCH daughters track squarely on their rear legs and have ideal flex to the hock. Daughters have plenty of strength and depth, but are smaller in their frame size.

Mating Information

Use PATCH in the heifer pens on daughters of BOLTON, DRAKE, GARRISON, REECE, SHOTTLE, NANSEN and MELODY.
