Her dam is an Ex-90 Jolt with nearly 200,000 lifetime. She goes back to the great Blackstar daughter Zara who produced one of the best records ever at the farm of over 41,000M , 1453F and 1315P, went Ex-91 and is GMD and DOM.

Daughter Information

Z-DUKE daughters have shown the large frames and dairy character expected from the Durham x Rudolph cross. Udders are his specialty with off-the-chart improvement. Expect high, wide, rear udders carried high above the hocks. You should protect him on feet and legs as daughters have a tendency to hock-in slightly with more set to the hock. His earliest daughters are producing very efficiently with exciting components from this protein and herd life improver.
