Family Information

Winnoch Penguin 90th gave over 100 tonnes of milk and was classified BFE93 in her 9th lactation, with EX93 Legs & Feet and EX94 Mammary. She was one of three EX maternal sisters and her dam and grand dam produced consistently well over many lactations.

UMPIRE is a maternal half brother of Winnoch Officer, who also has an excellent proof and is one of the highest PLI bulls of all time.

Dripps Rio, the sire of Umpire, was proven in Scotland where he was very popular with Friesian breeders, leaving good conformation and very high milk production. Rio's dam was an EX93 cow that gave over 12,000kg in her 4th and 5th lactations.

UMPIRE daughters give lots of milk and are very popular with their owners – they have excellent temperament.

UMPIRE sires medium sized Friesian type cows with very good Legs & Feet and good locomotion. They have impressive udders, with strong ligaments and good teat placement.
