His dam Cityview Ruby Wine Red is Excellent in the udder and was bred by Cityview Holsteins, a very well known respected herd in Canada. Ruby Wine-Red is a STBVQ Rubens daughter and has many outstanding progeny in the US. One of those being the Excellent Distrigene daughter, April-Day-D Burgundy-Red-ET, note her show record listed above and she continues to get better with age. WISCONSIN-RED'S sire is Ja-Bob Jordan (Phideaux*RC x Momentum-Red) an outcross sire that sires extreme fat.

Daughter Information

WISCONSIN-RED daughters are slightly taller and stronger than their herdmates. When viewed from the rear the daughters have level wide rumps, rear udders with much height that are carried well above the hocks and also as viewed from the rear they track straight on the rear legs. They have an above average foot angle and he will improve fore udders.

Mating Information

WISCONSIN-RED is more appealing than your typical red bull for calving ease and can be used on daughters of Advent, September Storm, Talent, DISTRIGENE-RED, KITE*RC and RAMPAGE-RED.
