STRATTON is a new twist on the successful Bomaz cow family. As with his family members at ABS – KYAN, DISCOVER, PATCH, HOMESTEAD and BOULDER there is no O-Man, BWM, Manfred, Patron, Formation, JUROR, CONVINCER, Rudolph, Outside, Mtoto, DUSTER or Leadman in any of their pedigrees. STRATTON combines the consistent breeding pattern of the Laurie Sheik's with the outcross pedigree of Bomaz 1551 into one package!

Family Information

STRATTON was bred by Bomaz Farms where over 500 cows call a large well managed free-stall barn in Hammond, WI their home. STRATTON's sire, Lucky Star (Estimate x Rudolph x Lindy x Laurie Sheik) was a high percent, low calving ease bull with a pleasing type pattern. The MGD, 1617 was a medium sized cow with a near perfect udder and great feet & legs. Always a visitor favorite 1551, was a big massive all white cow with youthful udder and ideal feet and legs. ABS has invested heavily into the 1551 family but has reaped many proven bulls. The dam of 1551 is an awesome Highlight cow that made over 373,000 lifetime and is the only cow in the 7 generations behind STRATTON that tested less than 4.3% for fat. LOOKOUT 3249 has other sons sampled by ABS sired by Jose, Ramos, JET STREAM, Jardin, Active and Planet. 1617 has VG daughters by Cooper, Inquirer, Garter, Merchant, Finley, LOOKOUT, Lancelot (2) and Lynch. 1617 has two other active sons in AI...14HO4371 Belt and 11HO8419 AltaMercantile. 1617 has 12 VG and 1 EX maternal sister.

Daughter Information

STRATTON daughters leave their mark by having exceptional udder traits! They have youthful appearing udders held higher above the hocks with tightly attached fore udders. The daughters show plenty of height and width to their rear udders. In addition, their mammary systems have consistent quality and texture to them with very strong center support. Moreover, they are dairy and cleaned boned individuals that are sharper and angular throughout. They track very well on their feet and legs, especially from the rear, and show a more ideal set to the leg. Protect for teat size and strength.

Mating Information

Use STRATTON on milk cows to increase percents, PL and udders. Due to his outcross pedigree he might work best on daughters of SHOTTLE, BOLIVER and GRANDVIEW.
